GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES SERVING PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

Office of Adult Career and Continuing Education Services (ACCES-VR) - The state agency provides vocational and rehabilitation services, including job training and counseling for youth and adults with disabilities.

Office of People with Developmental Disabilities (OPWDD) - OPWDD provides services to eligible individuals, including supports for independent living, supportive and supervised residences, work and day activities, health care services, and service coordination.

Office of Mental Health (OMH) - Serves New York residents with mental health needs. Programs overseen by OMH include inpatient and outpatient programs, community support, residential supportive housing, and family care programs.

Social Security Administration (SSA) - Funds programs that provide benefits for people of any age who are unable to do substantial work and have severe mental or physical impairments. Apply online or call (800) 772 -1213 (TTY 1-800-325-0778) for an appointment.

New York State Commission for the Blind (NYSCB) - Provides pre-employment transition services to students ages 14 to 21, transition services to youth, and vocational rehabilitation services for all students who are legally blind, including those with additional disabilities.

Summer Youth Employment Program (SYEP) - Helps people ages 14-24 get work experience, life skills training, and income during the summer months. Youth with disabilities receive priority in the lottery.

Transitional Planning Assistance and Care Coordination Agencies:

Families living in New York City can select from one of the three care coordination organizations listed below. Families may switch care managers and/or CCO at any time. For those eligible for OPWDD services living in New York City, there are three Care Coordination Organizations.
